Year Over Year Median Sale Price GREATER YAKIMA VALLEY

In Yakima County, the median sale price has seen a slight decrease of 2.86%, likely influenced by sellers adjusting to the significantly higher mortgage rates faced by buyers. Despite this, inventory levels remain low, which is supporting home values. However, the market is feeling the effects of these higher rates, with buyer demand somewhat muted. As a result, there has been an increase in sellers assisting buyers with their closing costs. Nevertheless, certain areas of the county have experienced positive appreciation amidst these challenges.


